RESOLUTION 2019 - 04

A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of the San Juan County Public Hospital District #3, dba Orcas Island Health Care District (the "District"), San Juan County, Washington to approve and adopt the 2020 Budget.

WHEREAS, the District was formed by a vote of the residents of Orcas Island, Washington, during the April 24, 2018 Special Election; and

WHEREAS, the District requires a Budget for the year of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent presented the Proposed 2020 Budget at the Regular meeting of the Board on October 15, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board took public comment during a Public Hearing on the Proposed 2020 Budget during the Regular meeting of November 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined the cash on hand plus all anticipated revenues and did fix the appropriate amount for each expenditure line item; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration of the Proposed 2020 Budget and the public comments thereon, the Board desires to approve and adopt the District's 2020 Budget (Exhibit A);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SAN JUAN COUNTY PUBLIC HOSPITAL DISTRICT NO. 3, DBA Orcas Island Health Care District, set the final Budget for the year 2020 as attached hereto and incorporated as if fully set forth.
